<b>Prerequisites:</b>	None
<b>Course Description:</b>	This course will provide the student with demonstrations and hands-on activities that will teach the student how to install the Microsoft Windows Operating Systems troubleshoot and configure the Operating System. The course will also teach the students how to backup and restore the Windows registry files; it will also cover how to use the built in utilities to help maintain the Operating System.
